Personal Qualifications

The Student Pastor of LRBC is to be a man of God, who has ordered his life in compliance with the teaching of Scripture and the example of our Lord. He is to be an example to the believers in personal godliness (1 Timothy 4:12) and to exemplify God's requirements for a pastor which includes maintaining a proper Christian home (1 Timothy 3:1-7).

- Must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, through faith in Him as the Way, Truth, and Life.
- Must have and demonstrate a clear calling by God into the gospel ministry.
- Be fully committed to living a godly life both in public and private.
- Be fully committed to his family by lovingly leading his wife and children in life and ministry.
- Be committed to the ministry, philosophy, doctrine, and direction of Leesville Road Baptist Church and see his role as one of ministering to youth in order to become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ.
- See himself as a team player, willing to work within the boundaries of the pastoral staff and leaders involved in the Leesville Road Baptist Church.
- Be proficient in teaching the truths of the Bible to youth in a relevant and engaging way.

Student Ministry

To assist the Church and parents of LRBC in training our youth (6th-12th grade) to be fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ, in public and private life. To develop a student ministry philosophy and process which more fully develops our children & youth into disciples who can scripturally engage their generation with the gospel of Christ. To administer, develop, and implement student ministries and programs designed to meet the spiritual (know God's Word), social (live God's Word), and emotional (think God's Word) needs of students in the Church and community.

Duties

- Develop, oversee, and direct the ministries of Leesville Road Baptist Church to Youth (6th-12th grade) for the purpose of glorifying Christ (Sunday morning, Sunday night, Wednesday night, other activities, camps, mission opportunities, etc. by working alongside appropriate LRBC committees and the senior pastor).
- Pursue in word and deed the Great Commission as given by our Lord in Matthew 28:18-20 to make healthy disciples of Jesus Christ.
- Serve as a resource to parents & grandparents individually and to the Church collectively for the spiritual development of the youth group.
- Support LRBC through relationships, attendance, prayer, and financial giving.
- Encourage and help facilitate full inclusion of the youth into complete Church life (worship services & events).
- Take a lead role in teaching Sunday School/Discipleship classes.
- Create and maintain a calendar of events for the youth.
- Recruit chaperones for all youth events.
- Plan at least one mission trip or one youth camp per year.
- Aid in the budget process.

*You will be granted 2 Sundays and 2 Wednesdays to be used as paid vacation time. Any other absences can be approved by the personnel committee. Sick days are acknowledged and not included. It is your responsibility to have coverage in your absence.
